THE LATE REVEREND TIMOTHY GANZ

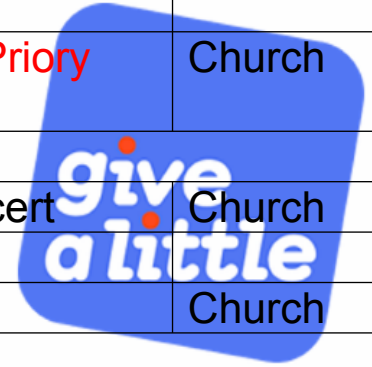
Contact has been made with the undertakers to begin the process of removing the stone to add Reverend Timothy's name to the grave stone of his parents.
