THE LATE REVEREND TIMOTHY GANZ

As you know Reverend Timothy was our Vicar for 23 years until his retirement.

He died in 2025 and his Cremated Remains were laid to rest with his parents in our churchyard. Unfortunately, there is no one of his family remaining who will arrange for the inscription which specified in his will to be put on the grave. It was therefore agreed at the PCC Meeting that we as a church arrange for his wishes to be carried out. The collection at Timothy's Memorial Service was towards the upkeep of the church, some of which could be used for this but if anyone would like to contribute towards the cost of removing and replacing the headstone with the following inscription added "and the Revd Timothy Jon Ganz, Vicar of Tutbury 1981-2004", it will be very much appreciated.
